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The award-winning Ndinogona “I Can” Stimulation program has been implemented across South Africa since 2013 to change perceptions about the rights of children with disabilities and their ability to play and learn. Building on our team’s success in South Africa, the program is now available in the US!

The training program was designed to empower individuals who work with children with disabilities on how to interact with children with disabilities, allowing them to play and participate in daily educational activities in an inclusive setting.

All children are unique and the program equips caregivers, parents, teachers or therapists with the ability to adapt teaching concepts, structured stimulation and play to create learning programs that are fun, safe and empowering for each child within their care. Play is vitally important to all children’s development, as play is the way that children learn about their world and practice important life skills enabling children to play and participate more in daily activities.



The program includes:

1. A curriculum for caregivers and educators with four themes: **All about Me, All about Food, All about Family and Community, and All about Learning.**
2. Activity manuals and adaptive equipment for over 100 activities and songs.
3. Training on how to implement this program at your setting.

Children with disabilities and their families face many barriers in their community and this often doesn't allow them to access any form of play or learning opportunities. Inclusion is important as it gives ALL children an equal opportunity to be included in their community, home or school environment.
